UNDECIDED/UNSURE

This is a very important election – there's a lot at stake choosing the leader of the Labour Party – and you can only exercise your choice if you vote. Keir is the candidate who will unite the party, bring all parts of the party together and take the fight to the Tories.

He has promised to keep our party radical, he opposes austerity, he supports common ownership and he believes public services should be in public hands.

TALKING POINTS

1. He will unite the party and bring all parts of the party together.
2. He has promised to stay radical and relevant – he opposes austerity and supports common ownership and believes public services belong in public hands.
3. He is a human rights lawyer and wants a human-rights based approach to foreign policy. He opposed the Iraq war and bombing Syria.
4. As a lawyer he has defended striking miners, the couple who were sued for libel by McDonalds for handing out leaflets outside their restaurants and motorway protesters. He also supported Doreen Lawrence in her fight for justice after the murder of her son Stephen.
5. He will tackle antisemitism in the party head-on. Keir has stated that if he is elected Leader, he will review the current cases weekly and take a personal lead and responsibility from the top. As the former Director of Public Prosecutions and lawyer he has both the legal and also organisational experience to regain trust in our party on this serious issue.
